PURPOSE, EXPECTATIONS AND TENURE THE CLUB PATRON



PURPOSE

The position of club patron generally refers to a well-known or illustrious individual who has a special interest or connection to the club and what it stands for and who consents to lend their name, position, and support to the club. Our club patron is not expected to have full membership rights, and does not need to be a fully paid up member.

EXPECTATIONS

Our club patron can do as little or as much as is agreed with them from time to time, but generally the role is an honorary appointment and is seen as being a ceremonial or a figurehead to promote the club where possible.

Their photograph and a brief history/profile will be displayed publically on the club website, and also used with their permission, on any club promotion or advertising material, when considered appropriate by the committee.

The patron can perform any specific functions as agreed, such as opening the AGM, presenting awards & trophies at the annual show n' shine event, or other such events as they arise.

The patron is not obliged to attend regular meetings unless they wish to do so, and unless they also hold Ordinary Membership in accordance with Part 3, Division 1 of the Club Constitution, they can only observe at meetings, and have no voting or decision making abilities in the conduct of the club.

TENURE OF APPOINTMENT

The position of Club Patron can be held for as long as they wish, on an ongoing basis, year to year.

Should either the patron or the club decide that the person can no longer support the role in the manner expected for whatever reason, a written termination of the role and the expiry date, can be issued at any time by either party, to the other.
